In-Person Attendance Policy Congregation Hugat Haverim

We are incredibly happy to welcome everyone back to in-person services, meetings and events. The health & safety of our members and clergy is of the upmost importance to us. The following policy has been written with input from the CDC, state and local health departments. The policy will be implemented at our next in person service and until health authorities recommend any changes. Vaccinated individuals are those who have received their last recommended dose of one of the three main Covid vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson), at least 14 days prior to the date of the event they are attending.

- 1. **Individuals who have been vaccinated** will not need to wear a mask, though they are welcome to do so. Vaccinated individuals will self certify.
- 2. **Unvaccinated individuals** (including children) are still required to wear masks and remain socially distanced from one another and from others in attendance at services and events.
- 3. **Onegs:** As a Circle of Friends social time with one another is especially important to us all. In an effort to include everyone, we will be suspending all onegs at this time.
- 4. At present, we are planning open attendance at High Holy Day services. We will have a section, socially distanced, for anyone not vaccinated who plans to attend.
- 5. All services and events will be "Hybrid". Both in-person and live streaming via zoom for those who wish to participate remotely.

This policy is subject to change at any time. We will continue to monitor the situation and recommendations from the CDC, state and local health departments. Any rule changes contrary to the above policy, instituted by The State of California Health Department or The Los Angeles County Health Dept, will supersede this policy.
